1. On the booking form, go to **Flight Facilities**



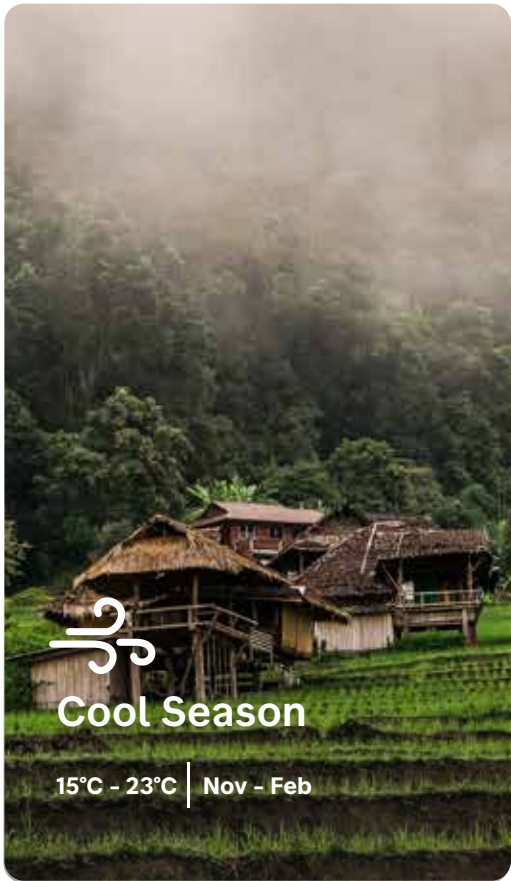
2. Tap **Baggage**

Dry Season

Wet Season

Thailand will see a lot of rain in this season, the most will be in October.

Cool Season

It's a bit colder and rain still falls sometimes, but less intensely.



The best time to visit Thailand

November - April

It's not too humid and not too hot, which makes this period a high season to visit the country.

♂ **Sà-wàt-dee kráp (สวัสดีครับ)**

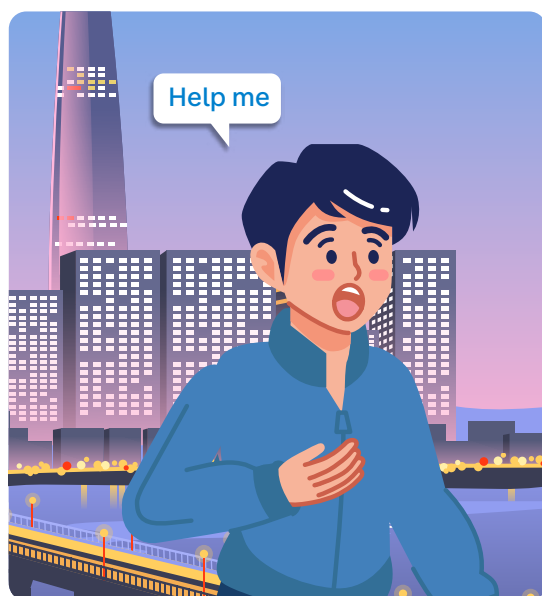

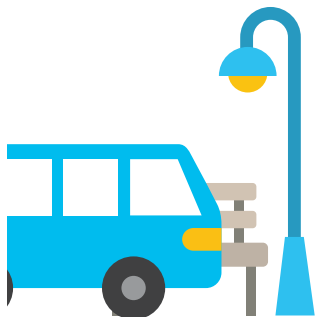

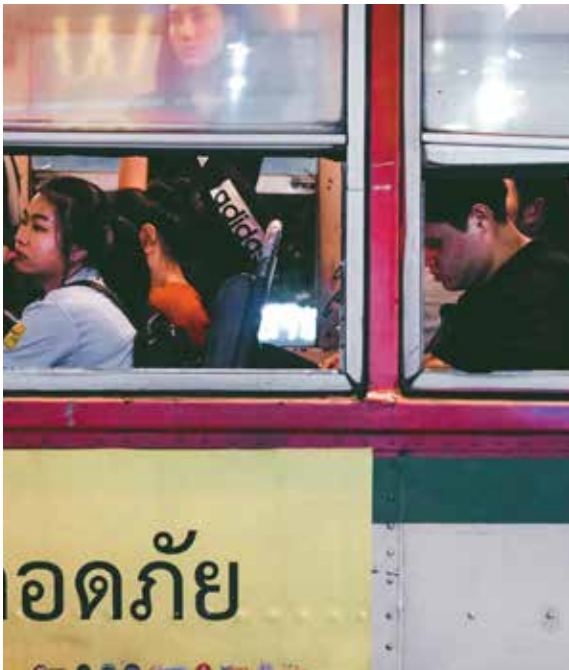


02. BTS Skytrain

Dress appropriately when visiting temples or other places of worship.

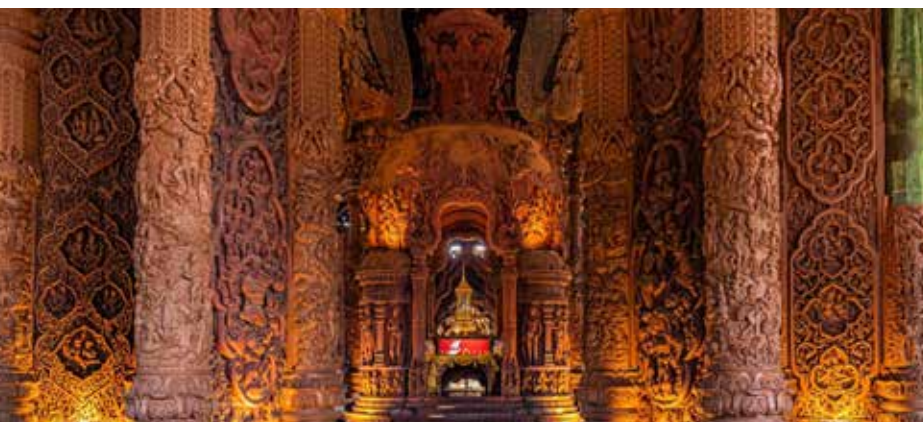


Touching someone's head in Thailand is considered impolite.

All cities throughout Thailand celebrate this festival, but one of the popular spots to celebrate it is Khao San Road in Bangkok. You'll see people's faces being smeared with talc, a white powder to protect the skin from the sun.

 April 13 - 15



Several tips if you want to join Songkran festival:

- Prepare water gun, bucket, and water balloon days before the festival
- Leave your electronic devices at the hotel or use waterproof cases
- Wear a slightly thick, dark-colored clothes
- Respect others while doing water-fight
