


How to Get Extra Baggage

Dry Season

→ Cool Season

It's a bit colder and rain still falls sometimes, but less intensely.



As a form of politeness, men have to end each of their sentence with ครับ (kráp) while women use ค่ะ (kâ)



Kŏr tôht (ขอโทษ)




Want to ask forhelp? Say: Chûay dûay! (ช่วยด้วย!)






O2.BTS Skytrain

Touching someone's head in Thailand is considered impolite.




Keep your distance from monks, and refrain from touching them.




Songkran

The three-day festival marking the start of the traditional Thai New Year and is all about making a fresh start with water, which is believed by locals as a symbol of purity.


All cities throughout Thailand celebrate this festival, but one of the popular spots to celebrate it is Khao San Road in Bangkok. You'll see people's faces being smeared with talc, a white powder to protect the skin from the sun.





Several tips if you want to join Songkran festival:

- Prepare water gun, bucket, and water balloon days before the festival
- Leave your electronic devices at the hotel or use waterproof cases
- Wear a slightly thick, dark-colored clothes
- Respect others while doing water-fight


